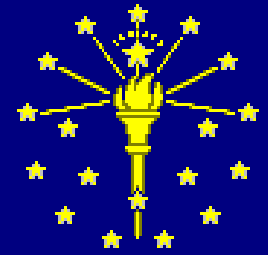

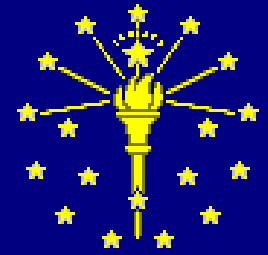


7 Signs and Signals of Terrorist Operational Activity

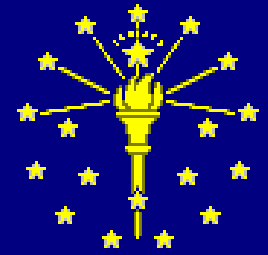

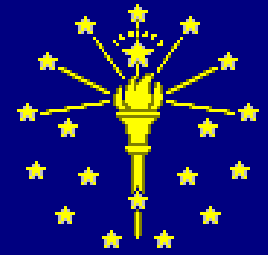
ELICITATION ... why it works

Elicitation exploits fundamental aspects of human nature

- **Most of us want to be polite and helpful, so we answer questions even from relative strangers.**
- **We want to appear well informed, so we may be tempted to say more than we should.**
- **We want to be appreciated and feel that we are doing something important and useful.**

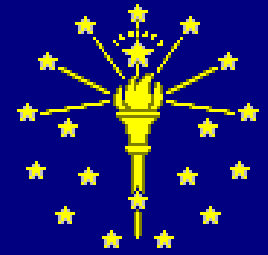


ELICITATION ... TTP

- Elicitation requires patience.
- A key objective in any elicitation operation is to make it as **EASY AS POSSIBLE** for the target to share his information.

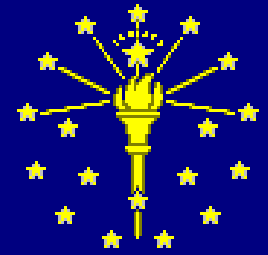


ELICITATION ... TTP ... *continued*

- Elicitation appears only to be normal conversation among colleagues, friends, and acquaintances.
- Just normal conversation in pleasant surroundings, like restaurants, hotels, conferences, or the homes of colleagues.

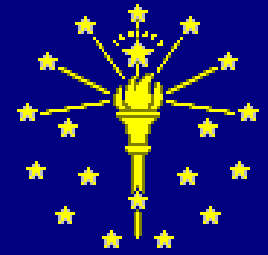


ELICITATION ... counter measures

- **Be aware to whom you are speaking and to whom your conversation may be reported. Don't be paranoid just be careful.**
- **You are not obliged to tell anyone any information they are not authorized to hear.**
- **You can simply ignore any question you think is improper.**
- **If appropriate, simply say you don't know.**

SURVEILLANCE ...

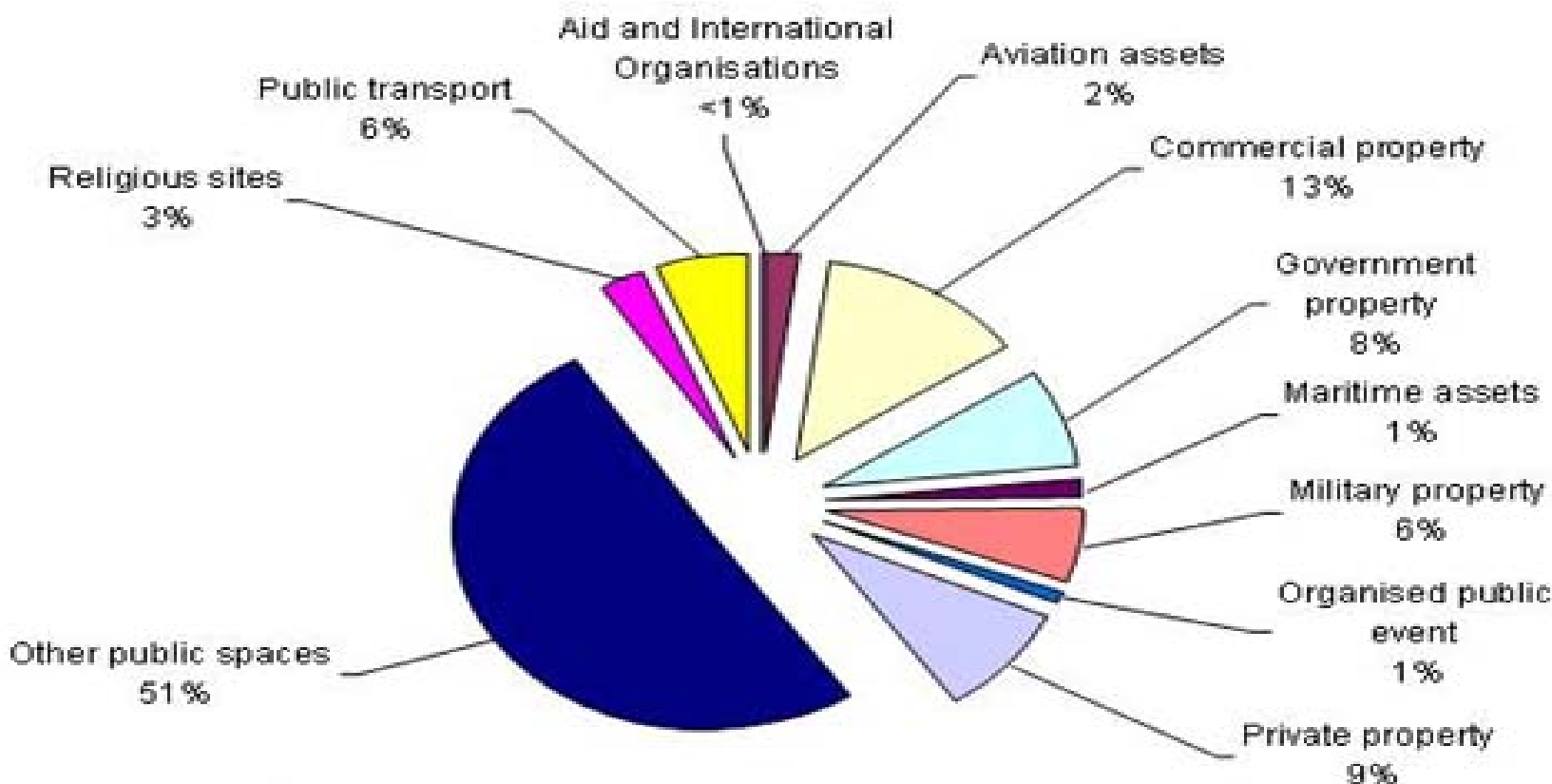
A common thread in all the terrorism warnings is that PRE-OPERATION SURVEILLANCE, including still and video photography, is a key indicator of impending terrorist activity.

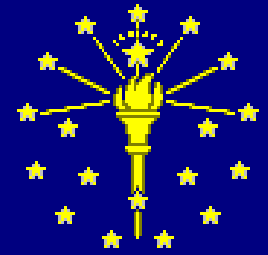
Categories of terrorist target 1999-2003

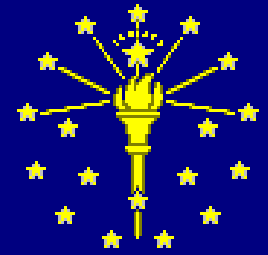
SURVEILLANCE ... indicators

Individual (or group) observed near the facility with....

- **High powered observation or camera equipment**
- **Maps or drawings of facility infrastructure**
- **Loitering, standing, or parking with no apparent reason or explanation. (May be over a multiple day period).**

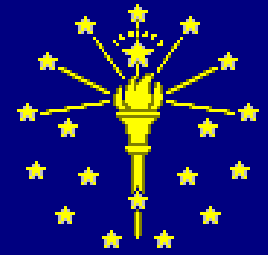
SURVEILLANCE ...

indicators ... continued

- **A noted pattern of 'false alarms requiring LE or EMS responses.**
- **Theft of ID cards, license plate, or uniforms.**
- **Employees being questioned about facility.**
- **Recent damage to facility fences, gates, or other locked infrastructure.**
- **Computer Network intrusion by hackers**

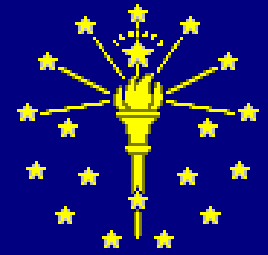
SUSPICIOUS ACTIVITY

Watch for unusual or out of place activity that might indicate surveillance is taking place.

- Multiple sightings of the same suspicious person, vehicle or activity.**
- Individuals who stay at a bus or train stop while busses/trains come and go.**
- Joggers who stand and stretch for an inordinate amount of time.**

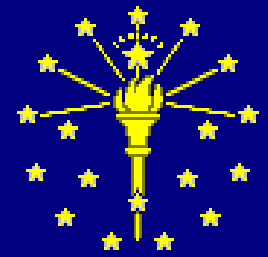
SUSPICIOUS ACTIVITY ...
continued

Watch for unusual or 'strange' behavior that might indicate surveillance is taking place.

- **Individual who doesn't fit into the surrounding environment.**
- **Individuals drawing, making notes or taking pictures of places that are of little or no interest to tourists.**
- **Staring or looking off into space. Avoiding eye contact.**
